## A Planter for Peter

How to upcycle a wooden crate to use as a planter

## You will need:

- Wooden crate
- Blue and white paint
- Paintbrush
- Peter Rabbit stencil (on next sheet)
- Sticky tape
- Membrane
- Staple gun
- Potting compost
- Selection of herbs or seedlings
- A trowel

## Step by step

- Take your blue paint and paint the entire outside of the crate. Set aside to dry
- Print off and cut out your Peter Rabbit stencil
- Tape the stencil on one side of the crate and dab white paint to create a rabbit silhouette
- Place the membrane inside the crate and using the staple gun, attach around the top and bottom
- Trim off any excess membrane and add potting compost to the crate
- Add your herbs or seedlings, place in a sunny spot and water well!

NB: Please supervise children at all times during this activity.
