Mrs Tiggy-winkle's Hanging Baskets

How to upcycle a colander to use as a hanging basket

You will need:

- Colander with handles
- Twine, cord or rope
- Plant membrane
- Trailing herbs or flowers
- Potting compost
- Trowel

Step by step

- Cut your plant membrane into a circular shape slightly larger than the diameter of the colander
- Take your twine or rope and cut four lengths measuring 50cm each
- Tie the ends of each piece to the handles of the colander, cut off any excess and move to one side
- Place the plant membrane inside the colander
- Carefully add your trailing herbs or flowers to the colander
- Fill any gaps with compost
- Gather your four ends or twine and holding above the colander, tie them together
- Hang your planted colander in a sunny spot!

NB: Please supervise children at all times during this activity.
