





#### **AMAZING NATURE FACTS**

Peter Rabbit is learning all about nature in *Peter's Nature Walk*. Here are just some of the fascinating facts he discovers about the great outdoors . . .



To escape the winter, some birds go on long journeys to reach warmer parts of the world. And when spring arrives, the birds travel back again. Tiny swallows cover 200 miles per day, travelling from South Africa to spend the summer in the British Isles. This is called migration.

Frogs start life as tiny jelly-like eggs called frogspawn. They then turn into tadpoles, before they develop legs and become little froglets. Finally they grow into frogs, like Mr. Jeremy Fisher.





Once a Caterpillar is fully grown, it finds a hidden place and forms a safe coating around itself called a pupa. Inside the pupa, something magical happens...and the caterpillar emerges as a butterfly!

Bees are pollinators. When they collect nectar for making honey, pollen from the flower rubs on to the bee's body. The bee then carries that pollen to another flower, where it gets left behind and seeds can grow. These seeds will turn into new plants. This is called pollination.





Some animals, such as bats and owls, are nocturnal. This means that they sleep during the day and are most awake and active at night.

Peter Rabbit and his mother have hopped into the woods to explore nature! Can you help them find their way back home? Which animals and birds will you find along the way?










## **NATURE SPOTTER**
